In compliance with the requirements of the Public Procurement Act, 2007, and in pursuance of its statutory mandate, the NLTF Management intends to undertake the procurement of under listed goods, works and services. 3.0 ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Interested contractors are required to submit the following documents:

 a. Evidence of Certificate of Incorporation issued by Corporate Affairs
- Evidence of Certificate of Incorporation issued by Corporate Affairs
 Commission (CAC) including Forms CAC2 and CAC7. Business Name
 is also acceptable for Service;
- Evidence of Firm's Tax Clearance Certificate (or Personal Income Tax Clearance Certificates of all the Partners in case of Business Name) for the last three (3) years valid till 31st December, 2022;
- C. Evidence of Pension Clearance Certificate valid till 31st December, 2022 (this requirement is only applicable to bidders whose number of staff is 15 and above);
- d. Evidence of Industrial Training Fund (ITF) Compliance Certificate valid till 31st December, 2022 (this requirement is only applicable to bidders whose number of staff is 5 and above or the bidder's annual turnover is N50m and above);
- Evidence of Nigeria Social Insurance Trust Fund (NSITF) Clearance Certificate valid till 31st December, 2022;
- f. Evidence of Registration on the National Database of Federal Contractors, Consultants and Service Providers by submission of Interim Registration Report (IRR) expiring on 31/12/2022 or valid Certificate issued by BPP.
- g. Sworn Affidavit disclosing whether or not any officer of the relevant committees of the National Lottery Trust Fund or the Bureau of Public Procurement is a former or present Director, shareholder or has any pecuniary interest in the bidder and to confirm that all information presented in its bid are true and correct in all particulars:
- h. Company's Audited Accounts for the last three (3) years 2019, 2020, 2021 duly acknowledged by the Federal Inland Revenue Service
- Reference Letter from a reputable commercial bank indicating willingness to provide credit facility for the execution of the project when needed;
- j. Company's Profile with the Curriculum Vitae of Key Staff to be deployed for the project, including copies of their Academic/Professional qualifications such as COREN, QSRBN, ARCON, CORBON etc.;
- K. Services: Evidence of Firm's registration with relevant regulatory professional body such as COREN, OSRBN, ARCON, CORBON, etc.;
- Verifiable documentary evidence of at least three (3) similar jobs executed in the last five (5) years including Letters of Awards, Valuation Certificates, Job Completion Certificates and Photographs of the projects;
- M. Only companies included in the National Automotive Design and Development Council's approved list of local manufacturers of vehicles or their authorised representatives should bid for the vehicles;
- n. Medical Equipment: Letter of Authorisation from the Original Equipment Manufacturers listed in the Approved Policy for Procurement of Health and Medical Equipment for Tertiary Hospitals

The Letterhead Paper must bear the Names and Nationalities of the Directors of the Company at the bottom of the page, duly signed by the authorised officer of the firm.

- i. All submission must be made in English language
- ii. No Bidder shall Bid for more than two (2) Lots in total
 iii The Agency is not under any obligation to accept the lowest bid.

- False claims and failure to comply with the instruction above or to provide any of the listed document shall automatically lead to disqualification;
- Nothing in this advertisement shall be construed to commitment on the part of the agency for acceptance of the tender;
