DUTIES:

- Coordinate characterization and diversity assessment activities of the collections and ensure the supply of germplasm.
- Coordinate germplasm conservation activities for long-term and medium-term storage.
- Monitor viability level of conserved germplasm.
- Ensure safety duplication of accessions in Svalbard Global Seed Vault and in another CGIAR Genebank.
- Perform regeneration and multiplication of germplasm as may be necessary.
- Liaise with IITA Germplasm Health Unit (GHU) for seed health testing and cleaning for conservation and distribution.
- Write reports on various genetic resources conservation activities and coordinate local and international seed request and distribution.
- Design and execute research projects on Plant Growth Regulator use, and also carry out germplasm exploration when necessary.
- Perform any other job-related task as may be assigned by the supervisor.
