 Planning Calendar and all the portfolio management events for both the Front-End and Project Delivery Portfolios
 and across all Sub-Portfolios (i.e. Plant, Infrastructure, Pipeline/GTS and Community)
- Updates and ensures the accuracy of the portfolio management templates, forms, checklists etc. required for the
 performance of all the portfolio management activities.
- Acts as the secretary to the portfolio Decision Review Board (DRB) and ensures accuracy and completeness of portfolio related submissions (including reports) to the portfolio DRB.
- Prepares periodic portfolio performance/status reports for the Portfolio Manager and Portfolio Sponsor.
- Responsible for maintaining an accurate portfolio database, in collaboration with Portfolio Leads.
- Maintains a Five-year CAPEX demand forecast.
- · Maintains a Five-year FTE demand forecast
- Maintains a Project Portfolio Value Summary database.
