Role purpose

The role holder will support Christian Aid's response to the humanitarian crisis in Nigeria, ensuring MEAL activities is effectively implemented across multiple projects in the humanitarian sector. The role holder will assist in the implementation and monitoring of Christian Aid's MEAL & Humanitarian Response, providing effective and timely support as required. The role profile is to ensure Humanitarian projects are of pre-requisite quality and comply with accountability standards. He/She is to ensure CFM structures within humanitarian projects are set up and effective in receiving, resolving and giving feedback.
